2018 QUILT FEST – GENERAL INFORMATION AND QUILT CATEGORIES THIS WILL BE A JUDGED SHOW

NOTE: A quilt consists of 3 layers: 2 layers of cloth filled with "batting" material held together by stitched design. Quilt may be embellished with material other than cloth, but tied quilts will not be accepted.

ALL QUILTS MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED BY: June 15, 2018

- 1. Mail completed form to: Quilt Registration, c/o Virginia Franklin,96 First South Shores Ave., Decatur, IL 62521
- 2. One form required for each quilt or item, fill out top and bottom and sign in two places.
- 3. Non-member fee for entry is \$1.00 per quilt entered. (Payable to Decatur Quilt Fest) All quilt fees may be deducted from purchased Decatur Quilters Guild membership.
- 4. Judged entries are limited to one quilt per category with maximum of 13 quilts per exhibitor.
- 5. **Only quilted items are considered for judging**. Yo-Yo quilts, crazy quilts, panel (pre-printed fabric) quilts, or cathedral windows without batting will not be judged. If you have questions call the number below.
- 6. The registration committee reserves the right to refuse any quilt. The judge reserves the right not to judge a quilt. All judged items will receive a written evaluation from the judge.
- 7. Quilt Drop Off: Decatur Civic Center on Thursday, June 28, 2018, 9:00 am to 11:00 am
- 8. Quilt Pick Up: Decatur Civic Center on Saturday. June 30, 2018 between 5:00 pm and 5:45 pm

In order to organize our quilt show, we have assigned categories to quilts depending on their age, size, type, and methods used.. THE CATEGORY MUST BE ACCURATE. ANY ITEM(S) ENTERED INAPPROPRIATELY WILL BE DEEMED NOT ELIGIBLE FOR JUDGING IN ANY CATEGORY. IF YOU HAVE QUESTIONS, CALL THE NUMBER ABOVE.

QUILT CATEGORIES - QUILTS OVER 64" ON ANY SIDE

100	Antique	A quilt that was finished over 75 years ago, including the top, quilting, and binding. Any technique of piecing, applique or embroidery. Machine or hand quilted.
200	Appliqué	The predominant design element must be appliqué that is made by cutting shapes of one or more fabrics and applying them to the surface of another fabric sewn by hand or by machine. Quilting by hand or machine.
300	Embroidery	Embroidery predominant throughout by hand or machine. Quilting by hand or machine.
400	Mixed Technique	An even amount of both piecing and applique, or embroidery (hand or machine) is used to develop the design. Quilting by hand or machine.
500	Pieced	Pieced by hand or machine and quilted by hand.
600	Pieced	Pieced by machine and quilted using machine free motion quilting.
700	Pieced	Pieced by machine and quilted using machine with computer enhanced technique.
800	Whole Cloth	Whole cloth quilts. Quilting by hand or machine.
900	Other Techniques	Includes heavily embellished quilts and those with very special techniques such as thread art or trapunto. Includes quilts not eligible for judging such as: predominantly panel quilts, 2 layer quilts such as: yo-yo quilts, crazy quilts, cathedral window quilts.

QUILT CATEGORIES - SPECIAL SIZING

1000	Baby Quilts	Max of 64" on any side Crib Quilts for a child using any method of piecing/quilting.
1100	Miniature	Max of 24" x 24" on any side Quilts that are scaled from full size designs to a miniature size.
1200	Small Wall Hanging	Max of 36" on all sides Quilted piece that may or may not be made for the purpose of hanging on a wall.
1300	Large Wall Hanging	Minimum of 36" but Max of 64" on all sides. Quilted piece that may or may not be made for the purpose of hanging on a wall.

SPECIAL QUILTS BY YOUTH - AGES 8 to 16 - SPECIAL BALLOTING TO BE HELD

1500 Quilts by Youth No minimum size, but no larger than 64" on any side. 80% of quilt must be done by the child. Youth entrants will be voted for best quilt by attendees to show. First place will win a sewing machine

GUILD MEMBERS ONLY (NOT ELIGIBLE FOR VOTING)

5000 Rail Quilts Quilts from Guild Members for display on the upper railing.

5001 Challenge Quilts from Guild Members for 2018 Quilting Challenge and Lincoln Legacy Quilts
